Coronavirus

Steve noted that he had become concerned about many attendees at Park street dances not wearing masks. He sent an email to the organizers of the three dances about the risks entailed, and he received responses. More importantly, the next time he attended the dances, everyone was wearing masks.

John H. proposed conducting a webinar for Park residents concerning preparations residents can make to prepare for this year's fire season, which is expected to be particularly brutal. It would include information on such topics as cleaning gutters and maintaining hardscape within 5 feet of their residences.
