Reports

Coronavirus

No change. That is, as far as we know, Marin Valley remains Covid-free, which is likely a direct result of residents and visitors adhering to local and state health care directives, mainly wearing masks – correctly – and maintaining social distance.

Firewise

Regarding PSPSs and rolling blackouts, we probably will have neither this year, but that can always change.

John F. reported on the Park-wide evacuation exercise that was held on Saturday, October 10. In addition to the tube flyer and the article in the October *Echo*, two robocalls were sent, one on Thursday and another one to start the exercise on Saturday morning. About 112 households participated, and overall the exercise went very well. Several residents have sent congratulatory emails. John F. will write a follow-up article for the *Echo*.

Park Security

Kevin continues to monitor the area in and around the Park, and he has noticed no new camping activity lately. As always, Park residents are asked to be vigilant and report any suspicious goings-on to Matt Greenberg.

Matt has reported that the new security camera's installation on Marin Valley Drive near the laundry room is now complete. The new camera array will aid police in identifying those occasional outsiders intent on committing burglary or other crimes within our community.
