## Coronavirus

Though the mask mandate for indoor spaces has been lifted for Marin County, many people will continue the practice, as there are new variants. Residents are reminded to get tested if they suspect they have been exposed, even if they have no symptoms, and also that a second booster vaccination shot is available for people over 50 years old. Jay Shelfer brought up the fact that there is now a pill that can be prescribed to mitigate symptoms if its use is begun within a few days of contracting the virus.

### Park Safety/Security

Kevin reported that he knows of no thefts reported this week within the Park, and that there is no update on the nightwatch program.

Kevin reminded the committee that residents who see an actual crime in progress should immediately call 9-1-1; otherwise, all suspicious persons or circumstances should be immediately reported to Matt Greenberg, Park General Manager, by calling 415-883-5911, day or night, and Matt will take appropriate action. If residents can take photographs of suspicious vehicles or individuals without their knowledge, that is helpful, but residents should usually avoid confronting suspicious persons as this can prove dangerous.

#### Fire Safe Marin

John H. reported that the next meeting of the Fire Safe Marin Board of Directors will be Wednesday, June 24 at 9:00 a.m. and can be accessed through the Fire Safe Marin website.

John H. reported that the next Firewise Leaders meeting will be Friday, May 11 at 11:00 a.m. on Zoom and can be viewed via the FSM website as well as marinvalley.net.

John H. reminded the committee about the Ember Stomp event of May 28 from 11:00 to 5:00 at the Marin Civic Center.

John H. reported that the report from FSM's Mobile Home Wildfire Safety Committee is now posted on FSM's website as well as on marinvalley.net. There will also be a brochure sent to all the mobile home parks in Marin.

## Marin Valley Firewise

John H. reported that he has not yet received news about the outcome of the proposal he submitted for a \$10,000 PG&E grant for the maintenance of defensible space, specifically for the area near 199 Marin Valley Drive.
